6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to searches by agents of  
7 the Department of Fish and Game; amending  
8 Sec. 22, Art. I, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and  
9 providing for an effective date."  
10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
11 Section 1. Sec. 22, Art. I, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended  
12 to read as follows:  
13 Sec. 22. POWER TO SEARCH WITHOUT WARRANT. Any of  
14 the named persons may search without warrant any thing or  
15 place so long as the search is reasonable [OR IS NOT PRO-  
16 TECTED FROM SEARCHES AND SEIZURES WITHOUT WARRANT WITHIN  
17 THE MEANING OF ARTICLE I, SECTION 14, OF THE STATE CONSTI-  
18 TUTION, WHICH SPECIFICALLY ENUMERATES "PERSONS, HOUSES  
19 AND OTHER PROPERTY PAPERS AND EFFECTS." HOWEVER, BEFORE  
20 ANY SUCH SEARCH IS MADE A SIGNED WRITTEN STATEMENT BY THE  
21 PERSON MAKING SUCH SEARCH SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE PERSON  
22 IN CONTROL OF THE PROPERTY OF OBJECTS TO BE SEARCHED, AND  
23 THE REASON SUCH SEARCH IS BEING CONDUCTED ]. A written re-  
24 ceipt shall be given by the person conducting the search  
25 for any property which is taken as a result of the search.  
26 [THE ENUMERATION OF SPECIFIC THINGS SHALL NOT LIMIT THE  
27 MEANING OF WORDS OF A GENERAL NATURE IN THIS SECTION.]  
28 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
29 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
