SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring an applicant for a commercial fishing license to file an affidavit of payment of the Alaska net income tax; amending Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. ISSUANCE OF LICENSES. a. Licenses herein required shall be issued to any qualified person by the Commissioner or his duly authorized deputies, pursuant to written application accompanied by the required fee and containing such reasonable information as may be required by the Commissioner. Such applications shall be simple in form and be executed by applicants or their respective agents under the penalties of perjury.

b. An application for a commercial fishing license shall include a sworn affidavit on a form furnished by the Commissioner, executed before an officer of the state authorized to administer oaths, stating, under the penalties of perjury, that the applicant has filed or has paid any net income tax due the state for the years 1960 and 1961, or has filed or paid his net income tax return for the years 1960 and 1961, or, if the applicant did not file an Alaska net

income tax return for the previous years that he did not
earn income in Alaska during those years.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
