6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring an applicant for a commer-  
7 cial fishing license to file a signed state-  
8 ment of filing of the Alaska net income tax  
9 return; amending Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 94,  
10 SLA 1959; and providing for an effective  
11 date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959, is amended  
14 to read:

15 Sec. 3. ISSUANCE OF LICENSES. a. Licenses herein re-  
16 quired shall be issued to any qualified person by the Commis-  
17 sioner or his duly authorized deputies, pursuant to written  
18 application accompanied by the required fee and containing  
19 such reasonable information as may be required by the Com-  
20 missioner. Such applications shall be simple in form and be  
21 executed by applicants or their respective agents under the  
22 penalties of perjury.

23 b. An application for a commercial fishing license  
24 shall include a signed statement on a form furnished by the  
25 Commissioner stating, under the penalties of perjury, that  
26 the applicant has paid any net income tax due the state for  
27 the previous tax year, or has filed his net income tax return  
28 for the previous tax year, or, if the applicant did not file  
29 an Alaska net income tax return for the previous tax year,

that he did not earn income in Alaska during that year. The Commissioner shall reject no license application for the sole reason of failure to pay a tax.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
