HOUSE BILL NO. 406

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of state construction equipment to political subdivisions; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works is authorized to transfer directly to any political subdivision of the State, the title to any automotive and construction equipment which can be utilized in the maintenance or construction of roads and airports. No such equipment may be transferred unless it is in excess of known state requirements, and is intended for use, to some extent, to maintain and construct airports or roads which the State has an obligation to maintain or construct. The Commissioner shall determine how the equipment is to be allocated in the best interests of the state.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
