For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the commissioner of fish  
7 and game to provide the governor with com-  
8 plimentary fishing and hunting licenses for  
9 distribution to certain visitors; amending  
10 Sec. 1, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and pro-  
11 viding for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959, is amended to

Section 1. LICENSES AND TAGS REQUIRED. It shall be un-

16

lawful, except as otherwise permitted in this Act, for any per-

17

son to engage in sport fishing, including the taking of razor

18

clams, hunting, trapping, guiding, fur dealing, fish, fur, or

19

game farming, or taxidermy, without having first procured the

20

appropriate licenses or tags as hereinafter provided, and

21

without having such licenses or tags in his actual possession.

22

The commissioner of fish and game shall annually, at the re-

23

quest of the governor, provide him with not to exceed 20 com-

24

plimentary fishing and hunting licenses which the governor

25

may distribute to distinguished visitors to Alaska at his

26

discretion for their use in any one ten-day period during their

27

visits to the state. The complimentary license for sport fish-

28

ing or hunting, or both, shall be inscribed by the governor

29

with the inclusive dates for its authorized use. The

complimentary license exempts the authorized visitor from  
payment of the nonresident and alien big game tags otherwise  
required under Sec. 2 of this Article.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
