6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for a preference to
7 veterans in the disposition of certain
8 state lands."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Art. IV, Ch. 169, SLA 1959 as amended by Sec. 9,
11 Ch. 61, SLA 1960 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 N Sec. 4. VETERANS PREFERENCE. a. Before offering to
13 E the general public any unoccupied residential lands, the
14 W Director shall offer the land at a restricted sale, at which
15 only veterans may buy, to be held from 30 to 60 days before
16 the offering to the general public.

17 b. For purposes of this Act, the term "veteran" means
18 any person with 90 days or more of active service in the
19 armed forces of the United States who has been honorably
20 discharged after having served during any period between
21 April 6, 1917, and December 1, 1919, between September 16,
22 1940, and December 31, 1947, or between June 27, 1950, and
23 January 31, 1955.

24 M c. The director shall not sell the lands under this
25 A section at less than their fair appraised market value. The
26 T director shall make regulations necessary to ensure that
27 T lands sold under this section are for bona fide residential
28 E use, and not for speculation.
