HOUSE BILL NO. 441

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for special permanent identification plates for historic vehicles; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. RECOGNITION. The State of Alaska recognizes the pleasure received by the owners and general public from the driving and viewing of historic vehicles, and therefore provides for the issuance of special identification plates for such vehicles.

Sec. 2. The words "historic vehicle" mean any motor vehicle manufactured in the year 1935 or prior thereto, which is operated or moved over the highway for the primary purpose of historical exhibition or for a similar purpose.

Sec. 3. The special identification plates for historic vehicles shall be issued to the owners of the vehicles upon application in the manner prescribed by the Commissioner of the Department of Revenue.

Sec. 4. The special identification plates assigned to historic vehicles shall run in a separate numerical series, commencing with "Historic Vehicle No. 1", the plates shall be of a distinguishing color, and shall bear the name of Alaska. No date shall appear on the plates.

Sec. 5. A fee of \$10.00 shall be charged for the issuance of the special identification plates for historic vehicles.

Sec. 6. The plates shall be permanent and shall not be

1 required to be replaced and shall remain with the vehicle upon
2 the sale or transfer of the vehicle.

3 Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
4 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
