BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3(13), Ch. 124, SLA 1951 is amended to

read:

(13) RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. Application for renewal

12

of a vehicle registration shall be made by the owner upon

13

proper application and by payment of the annual license tax

14

for such vehicle as provided by this act. The commissioner

15

may receive applications for registration or renewal regis-

16

tration and grant the same and issue new registration cards

17

and plates at any time prior to expiration of registration,

18

but no person shall display upon a vehicle the new registra-

19

tion plates prior to February [DECEMBER] fifteenth of the

20

year in [PRECEDING] which such plates are issued.

(3) REDUCED FEE FOR PORTION OF YEAR. Whenever a motor

24

vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer subject to registration

under this Act is registered on or after the first day of

26

December [SEPTEMBER] of any year, the tax shall be one-half

27

the annual license tax imposed hereunder; provided, however

28

that such vehicle shall not have been illegally operated on

29

the highways of the state [TERRITORY] prior to December

[SEPTEMBER] 1st of the year in which application for registration is made [; AND PROVIDED, FURTHER, HOWEVER, THAT THE MINIMUM LICENSE TAX SHALL BE \$6.25].

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
