6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating refunds of the pro-
7 ceeds of the tax on nonprofit electric and
8 telephone membership cooperatives to
9 municipalities, independent school districts
10 and public utility districts; and providing
11 for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The sum of \$108,551 is appropriated from the
14 general fund to the following municipalities, independent school
15 districts, and public utility districts in the listed amounts as
16 refunds of the portion of the tax on nonprofit electric and tele-
17 phone membership cooperatives earned within such jurisdictions
18 during 1961 according to the provisions of Sec. 33, Ch. 93, SLA
