HOUSE BILL NO. 467

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating \$2,331.50 to the Department of Public Safety for reimbursement of expenses incurred by the United States Department of the Army and the Bachner Company in flood control; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,754.00 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety to reimburse the United States Department of the Army for the cost of blasting materials used in breaking up a dangerous ice jam in the Anchor River area during the period January 25 through January 28, 1961.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$577.50 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety to reimburse the Bachner Company for the use of a backhoe used in flood control in the De Barr Road area near Anchorage during January, 1962.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
