HOUSE BILL NO. 483
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for Alaska recognition of oaths and notarial acts of Alaska residents in the military service; amending Chapter 2, Title 23, ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 2, Title 23, ACLA 1949, is amended by adding a Section 23-2-1A to read:

Sec. 23-2-1A. The State of Alaska and its political subdivisions recognize as valid for all purposes the oaths and notarial acts of residents of Alaska who are members of, or serving with, employed by, or accompanying the armed forces of the United States, and of their dependents being residents of Alaska, which are administered by or executed before the persons designated in or pursuant to Section 936, Title 10, United States Code, as amended, regardless of whether such oaths and notarial acts are administered or executed within or without the territory of the United States or prior or subsequent to the effective date of this Act. No additional or different formalities shall be required than those prescribed by Section 936, Title 10, United States Code, as amended.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
