SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to statute of limitations in criminal prosecutions; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1.02 of HCS for SB 119, The Code of Criminal Procedure (Ch. ___, SLA 1962), is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 1.02. GENERAL TIME LIMITATION. A prosecution for murder may be commenced at any time. Except as otherwise provided by law, no person shall be prosecuted, tried, or punished for any offense, not murder, unless the indictment is found, or the information or complaint is instituted within five years next after such offense shall have been committed.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1963.
