SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Workmen's
Compensation Act; amending Sec. 18(4), Ch.
193, SLA 1959; and providing for an effec-
tive date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 18(4), Ch. 193, SLA 1959, is amended to
read:

(4) At such hearing the claimant, [AND THE] em-
ployer and the insurer of the employer may each present
evidence in respect to [OF] such claim and may appear in
person or be represented by a union representative, officers
or employees, licensed adjusters or counsel authorized to
practice law in Alaska [ANY PERSON AUTHORIZED IN WRITING FOR
SUCH PURPOSE]. Counsel admitted to practice before the
highest court of any other state may represent any party
before the Board under the same rules and conditions as pro-
vided for the appearance of out-of-state counsel before the
courts of the State of Alaska, pursuant to the Rules of
Civil Procedure. Any person or persons appearing before the
Board shall be responsible for his conduct to the Board, and
in addition Alaska counsel shall likewise be responsible to
the Board for the conduct of associate counsel from outside
the State of Alaska.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
