SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of heads of principal departments; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 105, SLA 1959, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Section 1. The head of each principal executive department of the state upon appointment and qualification shall receive an annual salary as determined by the governor but the department head shall not receive a salary in excess of the amount set opposite the titles listed below:

Adjutant General.	\$15,000
Attorney General.	18,000
Commissioner of Administration.	18,000
Commissioner of Commerce.	17,000
Commissioner of Economic Development and Planning.	17,000
Commissioner of Education	17,000
Commissioner of Fish and Game	17,000
Commissioner of Health and Welfare.	17,000
Commissioner of Highways.	19,000
Commissioner of Labor	17,000
Commissioner of Natural Resources	17,000
Commissioner of Public Safety	17,000
