HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 26

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the importation, sale,
and purchase of Russian canned
crabmeat in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, despite the urgent appeals of the Governor, Legis-
lature, and congressional delegation of Alaska, the United States
Government has lifted the ban on the importation of crabmeat from
Soviet Russia; and

WHEREAS, the lifting of the ban opens up a new and serious
threat to the economy of the state which has already suffered
from increasing encroachment of foreign fishing fleets in Alaskan
waters; and

WHEREAS, it behooves the people of Alaska to take all neces-
sary and possible precautions to protect its economy and dis-
courage the importation, sale and purchase in this state of
foreign products if such activities undermine our economy;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
Legislature, First Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that
the Governor of Alaska is respectfully urged to publicize the
evil effects of the importation, sale, and purchase of Russian
crabmeat and to ask that wholesalers, retail vendors, and the
purchasing citizens of Alaska volunteer to avoid the importation,
sale and purchase of Russian crabmeat in Alaska.
