BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE SECOND

8

LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, Alaska's geographically strategic location makes
10 it a natural hub for transpolar as well as transpacific great
11 circle air routes; and

12

WHEREAS, the State is presently engaged in making major
13 improvements at both the Anchorage and Fairbanks International
14 Airports to enable them to maintain their position among the
15 great airports of the world; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Aeronautics Board is presently con-
17 sidering a case commonly known as the Transpacific Route Case,
18 Civil Aeronautics Board, Docket No. 7723, et al., which involves
19 the request of Pan American World Airways to establish the
20 shortest possible route between the east coast of the United
21 States and the far east, with a stopover at Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this route would provide new
23 industry at the Fairbanks International Airport in the way of jet
24 fuel sales, and mechanical servicing of aircraft;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in the Second
26 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring,
27 that the Civil Aeronautics Board is urged to grant speedy and
28 favorable consideration to Pan American World Airways' petition
29 for the great circle route between New York and Tokyo; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed
2 to the Honorable John F. Kennedy, President of the United States;
3 the Civil Aeronautics Board; Mr. William Madden, Hearing Examiner
4 in Docket No. 7723 et al.; and to the Alaska delegation in Con-
5 gress.
