6 of the Alaska ferry system.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the vessels and facilities to be operated, under  
10 the state ferry system have been authorized and will be paid for  
11 by the people of the State of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS, one of the main purposes of the marine highway  
13 system is the fostering of economic development of given areas  
14 for the benefit of the entire state; and

15 WHEREAS, the economic development of the state is best  
16 realized through encouraging more people to settle in Alaska and  
17 to use of the services and merchandise of Alaskan enterprises;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
19 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that  
20 the Governor is respectfully urged to hold the Department of  
21 Administration and the Department of Public Works responsible  
22 for seeing that all personnel employed in the Alaska ferry system  
23 make their residences in the United States, except those employees  
24 whose duties are confined to the Prince Rupert terminal.
