HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 50
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the air strip at Ninilchik.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the present air strip near Ninilchik, located on the beach, is frequently unusable because high tides and storms wash it and cover it with debris; and

WHEREAS, the cannery and the high tension wires near the air strip create a constant flight hazard; and

WHEREAS, the homesteaders in the Ninilchik area are willing to donate private land located nearer to town, adjacent to the Oil Well Road, to be used as an air strip, and have already partially cleared it; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Aviation, Department of Public Works, has examined the proposed site, and has approved it as a suitable site for an air strip;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that the Governor is respectfully urged to direct the Department of Public Works, through the Division of Aviation, to relocate the Ninilchik air strip to the bench level adjacent to the Oil Well Road; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Richard A. Downing, Commissioner of Public Works; and the Honorable Eugene G. Roguszka, Director, Division of Aviation,
