IN THE HOUSE BY MESSRS. LEONARD AND HANSEN  
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 51  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction and  
naming of a bridge linking the  
Beaver Loop and Kalifosky  
Beach Roads at Kenai.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN SECOND  
LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Beaver Loop Road, within the City of Kenai,  
comes to within a few hundred feet of the Kalifonsky Beach Road  
on the beautiful shores of Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, the connection of these two roads by a bridge  
would be a vital link in the proposed "Kenai Peninsula Coastal  
Highway" adding immeasurably to the accessibility of this fast-  
developing area; and

WHEREAS, the people of the north central Kenai Peninsula  
favor the construction of this bridge and have indicated their  
desire that it be given the functional name of the "Kenai  
River Bridge" of the Kenai Peninsula Coastal Highway;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that  
the Governor is respectfully urged to have the Department of  
Public Works, Division of Highways, place the planning and  
construction of the proposed "Kenai River Bridge" on its  
priority list for early action and that the name requested be  
used for the bridge.
