5 Relating to the reorganization  
6 of local school districts.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the State Board of Education has considered the  
10 problems involved in getting school districts reorganized into  
11 constitutional forms of local government by July 1, 1963; and

12 WHEREAS, the State Board of Education has had under study  
13 proposed legislation entitled "Provisional Draft Legislation for  
14 Reorganization of Local School Organizations" and has requested  
15 the Legislature to give this draft legislation its consideration  
16 and study; and

17 WHEREAS, this work which has been done by the State Board  
18 of Education will be most helpful to the Legislature in providing  
19 for the orderly transition from present forms of local school  
20 organization to the forms of local government contemplated by  
21 Art. X of the Alaska Constitution, in those cases where the  
22 transition has not been voluntarily accomplished at the local  
23 level;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
25 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring,  
26 that the Legislative Council with the cooperation of the State  
27 Board of Education, the Department of Education, and the Local  
28 Affairs Agency, study the "Provisional Draft Legislation for  
29 Reorganization of Local School Organizations", hold such hearings

1 as may be found necessary, study and make such alterations to the  
2 proposed legislation, or draft such supplemental legislation as  
3 may be necessary to insure the orderly transition of local school  
4 districts to the constitutional forms of local government, and  
5 issue a report of their findings, their recommendations, and  
6 proposed legislation to the 1963 Legislature, first session.
