HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 59  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction  
of an access road from the  
Anderson Community to the  
Nenana-Clear Highway.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Anderson Community, Alaska, is in need of an  
access road to connect it with the Nenana-Clear Highway; and

WHEREAS, the construction of an access road in this area  
would greatly facilitate the transportation of children to school,  
the delivery of supplies to the community, and open up new areas  
to settlement and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the construction of this access road would be ex-  
tremely easy and inexpensive since a rough trail already exists  
and need only be widened and improved;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that  
the Governor is urgently requested to direct the Commissioner of  
the Department of Public Works to make a preliminary engineering  
study and then commence the construction of an access road  
connecting the Anderson Community with the Nenana-Clear Highway.
