

1 IN THE HOUSE BY RULES COMMITTEE
2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 61
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
5 Relating to the enrollment of
6 House Bill No. 120, as amended.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN SECOND
8 LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 120, as amended, (Uniform Commercial
10 Code) if formally enrolled would involve at least two weeks of
11 typing and proofreading; and

12 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Legislature that unnecessary
13 delay and expense be avoided in the final processing of this bill;

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
15 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that
16 Uniform Rules 59, 60 and 68 are suspended in their application to
17 House Bill No. 120, as amended, and that the following procedure
18 is authorized in handling the bill:

19 (1) Six copies of the bill as introduced along with the
20 amendments adopted by both houses will be certified as the
21 tentative enrolled copies by the certifying officers of the House
22 and Senate and transmitted to the Governor for his action.

23 (2) When the Governor has signed the tentatively enrolled
24 copy, the enrolling clerk will prepare it in suitable form for
25 the printer and upon return of the printer's copy it will be
26 proofread against the tentatively enrolled copy. The certifying
27 officers of each house will then certify the approved printer's
28 copy as the official enrolled version of the Act and deposit it
29 with the Secretary of State for permanent filing.
