BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN

SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the development of the travel industry is essential

12

to the economic well being of Alaska and its citizens; and

13

WHEREAS, the full and expedient development of that industry

14

is retarded by restrictions of the Civil Aeronautics Board which

15

deny the through passengers of foreign air carriers traversing

16

Alaska the privilege of stopping-over in Alaska; and

17

WHEREAS, these restrictions are contrary to the national

18

policy of encouraging travel by foreign nationals in the United

19

States, as demonstrated by the creation of the U. S. Travel Ser-

20

vice, and in other ways; and

21

WHEREAS, the effect of these restrictions is to deny to

22

domestic air carriers the benefits of revenues which would accrue

23

from travel within and beyond Alaska; and

24

WHEREAS, the removal of these restrictions would contribute

25

to the economy through increased expenditures for travel and

26

for other purposes, thereby easing the existing dollar drain:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in

Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the Legislature

29

does strongly protest the aforesaid restrictions as inimical to

1 the interests of the United States, the State of Alaska and the
2 domestic air carrier industry, and does endorse and support the
3 efforts of the State Administration in urging the Civil Aero-
4 nautics Board to rescind said restrictions; and be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to
6 the Honorable John F. Kennedy, President of the United States of
7 America; the Honorable Dean Rusk, Secretary of State; the
8 Honorable Alan Boyd, Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics Board;
9 the Honorable Luther Hodges, Secretary of Commerce; the Honorable
10 Voit Gilmore, Director of the U. S. Travel Service, Department of
11 Commerce; and to the Alaska delegation in Congress.
