SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 60  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of a cement cap on top of the south breakwater at Bar Harbor, Ketchikan, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS the U. S. Corps of Engineers recently constructed the Bar Point small boat harbor at Ketchikan, Alaska; and

WHEREAS the U. S. Corps of Engineers withheld approximately \$750,000 from the original Congressional appropriation for the future improvement of the harbor; and

WHEREAS, when the harbor was designed, the construction of a cement cap on top of the south breakwater was deferred until the breakwater had settled into place, which has occurred; and

WHEREAS the construction of this cement cap is now urgently needed for the protection it will provide against injurious wind and wave action during inclement weather;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in Second Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers is requested to construct with money already appropriated for future improvements a cement cap on top of the south breakwater at the Bar Point small boat harbor, Ketchikan, Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be mailed to the Honorable Elvis J. Stahr, Secretary of the Army; Colonel Christian Hanburger, District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, U. S.

1 Army; and the members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
