8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION  
9 ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, Irving McK. Reed has distinguished himself through  
11 years of unswerving devotion to the territory and the state as a  
12 mining engineer, the territorial highway engineer, and a citizen  
13 actively involved in the general development of Alaska; and

14 WHEREAS, the state of Alaska recognizes and applauds the  
15 accomplishments of one of its leading citizens; and

16 WHEREAS, the road now being constructed between Nome and  
17 Teller is informally referred to as the "Reed Line";

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
19 Legislature, First Session assembled, that the Governor is  
20 respectfully urged to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to  
21 designate the Nome-Teller road as the Irving McK. Reed Highway.
