HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.6

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to medical care for  
owner-operators of fishing  
vessels.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION  
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, there has been a long-standing need for federal  
legislation providing medical care for owner-operators of fishing  
vessels who are engaged on board in the care, preservation or  
navigation of such vessels; and

WHEREAS, Senator Warren G. Magnuson of the State of  
Washington and Senator E. L. Bartlett of Alaska, along with  
Representative Ralph J. Rivers of Alaska, have introduced identi-  
cal bills on this subject in both houses of Congress;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in the Second  
Legislature, First Session assembled, that Senators Warren G.  
Magnuson and E. L. Bartlett and Representative Ralph J. Rivers  
are complimented on their introduction of this vital legislation  
and assured of the support of the people of Alaska in their  
effort to have the legislation approved by the 87th Congress; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
the sponsors of the medical care legislation and the chairmen of  
the Committees on Foreign and Interstate Commerce of the House  
and Senate of the Congress of the United States.
