7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, the extension of transportation and communication
10 systems is vital for the sound development of Alaska and its
11 resources; and

12 WHEREAS, the construction of the Turnagain Arm causeway
13 should provide the citizens of the Palmer, Seward, Anchorage, and
14 Kenai Peninsula areas with better means of transportation and
15 communication; and

16 WHEREAS, a more direct link with the Palmer, Seward, Anchor-
17 age, and Kenai Peninsula areas will aid in the development of
18 railroad and highway transportation, oil and gas pipe lines and
19 power transmission lines; and

20 WHEREAS, the natural and scenic wonders of the Kenai Penin-
21 sula can be made more accessible to the tourist; and

22 WHEREAS, the construction of the causeway may also insure the
23 better defense of the Palmer, Seward, Anchorage, and Kenai areas
24 in the event of conflict;

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
26 Legislature, First Session assembled, that the Governor be re-
27 spectfully urged to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to
28 make reconnaissance, engineering and economic feasibility surveys
29 relative to the construction of the Turnagain Arm causeway.
