3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of
6 a school at Sterling, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, a general diffusion of knowledge is essential to
10 the preservation of the rights and liberties of the people; and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislature encourages the promotion of in-
12 tellectual and scientific improvement through the public schools;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, adequate physical and material facilities are
15 necessary before these purposes can be realized; and

16 WHEREAS, the number of school age children are increasing at
17 Sterling, Alaska, and the present classroom space is insufficient
18 for the education of these children; and

19 WHEREAS, the citizens of Sterling, Alaska, informed the
20 state Department of Education of their needs and statistically
21 substantiated their claims for additional classroom space;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
23 Legislature, First Session assembled, that the Governor is respect-
24 fully urged to direct the Commissioner of the Department of Edu-
25 cation to construct a new two-room school building with adequate
26 utility installations which could be utilized in the event of a
27 need for expansion.
