IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the town of Eagle.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, Eagle is an Alaska community wherein is located a
U. S. Customs office, located on the banks of the Yukon River; and

WHEREAS, the Yukon River through erosion has been undermining
the banks where the town of Eagle abuts the river; and

WHEREAS, the action of the Yukon River is endangering commer-
cial warehouses, resident homes, boat landing facilities, and a
church and parish hall; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that the U. S. Army Corps of En-
gineers is charged with the function of controlling the dangers
caused by river erosion;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
Legislature, First Session assembled, that the U. S. Army Corps
of Engineers is urged to take the proper steps in the spring of
1961 to survey and correct the condition at Eagle, caused by the
erosion of the Yukon River.
