5 Relating to official contact with
6 unincorporated communities.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, many communities in the state have not yet incorpo-
10 rated as cities but do have councils elected by the local
11 citizenry; and

12 WHEREAS, there are many occasions when agencies of the state
13 government must transact business in these communities or with
14 large segments of their population; and

15 WHEREAS, in transacting their business the state agencies
16 have been known to overlook the councils which are elected by the
17 people of the communities; and

18 WHEREAS, it would be mutually beneficial to the state and to
19 the unincorporated communities if state agencies transacting
20 business in these communities would contact and consult with the
21 elected councils;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
23 Legislature, First Session assembled, that all state agencies
24 transacting business in unincorporated communities contact and
25 consult with the elected councils of the communities in trans-
26 acting their business; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution in no way whatsoever
28 bestows any right or recognizes any right either corporate,
29 governmental, or tribal upon any unincorporated community or upon

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the elected council of any unincorporated community.
