HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 26

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to an appropriation for a
survey of mental health needs in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, a survey of Alaska's mental health needs, conducted
by an objective and independent non-profit professional mental
health organization will provide the Legislature and the state with
a factual and comprehensive study of Alaska's problems in this
area as well as with recommendations for implementation of the
state mental health program; and

WHEREAS, this survey should be completed as soon as possible
so that it can be made available to the Legislature and the
general public;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
Legislature, First Session assembled that the appropriation bill
being prepared by the House Finance Committee include an item
providing sufficient funds for a mental health survey to be con-
ducted by the American Psychiatric Association of Washington, D.C.
for the Division of Mental Health of the state Department of
Health and Welfare.
