5 Relative to the proposed comprehensive
6 ten-year program of oceanographic
7 research and surveys.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, there has been introduced in the present session
11 of the Congress a bill calling for a comprehensive program of
12 oceanographic research and surveys; and

13 WHEREAS, the program would include the rehabilitation of the
14 national commercial fishery, access and utilization of the ocean
15 fishery, fisheries exploration and marine resources conservation
16 and development; and

17 WHEREAS, the purpose and scope of the proposal made by
18 Senator Warren G. Magnuson in S. 901 are of vital concern to
19 Alaska and the nation in the conservation and development of their
20 vast marine resources, known and potential;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
22 Legislature, First Session assembled that the President and the
23 Congress of the United States are respectfully urged to give
24 favorable consideration to S. 901, the "Marine Sciences and Re-
25 search Act of 1961," and effect its passage and approval as soon
26 as possible; and be it
