2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 33

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the pavement of the
6 Alaska Highway.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED:

9 WHEREAS, the Alaska Highway including the Haines Cutoff is a
10 vital artery in the commerce of Alaska and its only land connection
11 with the Dominion of Canada and the United States proper; and

12 WHEREAS, this vital economic link was originally constructed
13 for and continues to be an essential aspect in the joint defense
14 effort of Canada and the United States; and

15 WHEREAS, the passage of the years and the increased use and
16 dependence on this basic highway demands that it be given proper
17 recognition through its pavement for year-round use;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
19 Legislature, First Session assembled, that the President of the
20 United States, in conjunction with the Secretaries of State and
21 Commerce, are respectfully requested to arrange consultations with
22 the Government of the Dominion of Canada and the affected provinces
23 looking towards a cooperative and mutually beneficial program to
24 effectuate the paving of the Alaska Highway in Canada and Alaska,
25 including the Haines Cutoff which, with the Highway, serves to
26 connect the Alaska road system; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to
28 the Honorable John F. Kennedy, President of the United States;
29 the Honorable Dean Rusk, Secretary of State; the Honorable Luther

1 H. Hodges, Secretary of Commerce; and the members of the Alaska
2 delegation in Congress.
