HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 48

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to providing the Halibut
Cove Community with a bulldozer.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the only access to the Halibut Cove Community,
near Homer, is by boat or by light plane, using an emergency
landing beach, usable only when the tide is out and the wind is
in the right direction; and

WHEREAS, there is need of a landing strip permitting more
frequent and dependable landings; and

WHEREAS, the inhabitants of the Halibut Cove Community are
willing to construct their own landing strip at no cost to the
state, but have for many years been unable to do so, because no
bulldozer is available;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
Legislature, Second Session assembled that the Commissioner of
Public Works through the appropriate division of the Department
of Public Works, is urged to give every consideration to the re-
quest of the Halibut Cove Community Organization for the loan of
a bulldozer for the purpose of clearing land for a landing strip.
