6 ence on joint use of public
7 water resources.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
9 ASSEMBLED:

10 WHEREAS, it is imperative to proper development and use of
11 the resources of the state that those resources be subject to
12 the maximum beneficial use by as many interests and persons
13 possible; and

14 WHEREAS, the beneficial use of the water resources of the
15 state are a matter of general concern to all and of particular
16 concern to those engaged in the fishing, logging, mining, oil and
17 gas, and other industries; and

18 WHEREAS, evidence of the seriousness of the problem of deter-
19 mining equitable rights and use has recently been before the
20 House; and

21 WHEREAS, there is an evident need for more concrete informa-
22 tion on the subject of joint use and for more cooperation and
23 understanding among the state and private groups concerned;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second
25 Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the Governor is urged
26 to direct the Commissioner of Fish and Game to gather comparative
27 information on joint use of state water resources and equitable
28 protection of all interests and then call a conference of repre-
29 sentatives of all interested agencies and groups to the end that

1 a reasonable compromise for a joint use program may be accomplish-
2 ed and put into operation.
