HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 58

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the utilization of  
certain legislative space.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN SECOND LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the space available to the Legislature on the second  
floor of the Capitol is inadequate to present needs; and

WHEREAS, there is now only one room available to the 60  
members for a combined cloakroom and lounge; and

WHEREAS, both necessity and convenience require that addi-  
tional space adjoining the present lounge be made available to  
the membership; and

WHEREAS, the small adjoining room now made available by the  
state to the press and inadequate to its needs is most suitable  
for use as a cloakroom for the membership;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in Second  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the Legislative  
Council is directed to request the Department of Administration  
to relocate the press room in more adequate quarters for its year-  
around coverage of state news elsewhere in the Capitol and to  
convert the present press room to a cloakroom for the members of  
the Legislature by January 1, 1963.
