IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state elections; amend-
ing Secs. 3.24 and subsec. (10) of Sec.
3.36, Ch. 83, SLA 1960."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3.24, Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is amended to read:

Sec. 3.24. ASSISTING VOTER BY JUDGE. Any qualified
voter who is incapable of reading, of marking the ballot
or of signing his name may request any judge to assist
him, and the judge shall assist the voter as requested, but
only in the presence of a judge of another political party.

Sec. 2. Subsec. (10), Sec. 3.36, Ch. 83, SLA 1960 is amended
to read:

(10) If a voter marks in the square designated
for voting a straight ticket for one political party and
also marks in a square for a particular candidate or candi-
dates of another party, a no-party candidate or a write-in
candidate, the ballot is not invalid and a vote shall be
counted for each candidate on the straight party ticket,
except no vote shall be counted for any candidate for the
office indicated by a mark in the square designated for vot-
ing the straight party ticket and a mark in the square for
a particular candidate or candidates of another party, a no-
party candidate, or a write-in candidate. [AND NO VOTE SHALL
BE COUNTED FOR A CANDIDATE OR CANDIDATES NOT ON THE STRAIGHT

PARTY TICKET.]
