SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the payment of costs for moving surplus property acquired by the state; amending Sec. 3, Ch. 120, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 120, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. The Department of Public Works will maintain cost accounting records reflecting the income and expenses of the fund and will submit a report on the operation of the fund to the governor and the legislature at the time of the submission of the departmental budget. All additions to or replacements of capital equipment or improvements to be paid from this fund are subject to annual appropriations by the legislature and shall be detailed in the executive budget. The cost of moving surplus property acquired by the state may be paid from the working capital fund without legislative appropriation. Rental and surcharge rates will be subject to annual review and approval by the governor.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
