6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the fish and game
7 resources of Alaska; amending Sec. 8, Art.
8 II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 as amended by Sec. 17,
9 Ch. 131, SLA 1960; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 8, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 as amended by
13 Sec. 17, Ch. 131, SLA 1960 is amended to read as follows:

14 Sec. 8. LICENSE FORFEITURE. Upon conviction of a
15 person of a first violation of any provision of this Article
16 or of any Federal or State law or regulation for the protec-
17 tion of the sport fish and game of Alaska, the Court may, in
18 addition to the penalty imposed by law, revoke the license
19 of such person. Upon subsequent conviction of any such
20 person or any violation of any provisions of this Article or
21 of any Federal or State law or regulation for the protection
22 of the sport fish and game of Alaska, the Court shall revoke
23 the license of such person, and no person whose license has
24 been so revoked shall purchase another license of the same
25 type for a period of not less than two years or more than
26 three years from the date of such revocation as determined
27 by the Court; provided further than any licensed guide or
28 assistant guide upon conviction of any provision of any
29 Federal or State sport fish, game or guide [GAME] law or

regulation may [SHALL] have his registered guide license or
assistant guide license revoked by the Court for any period
up to five years. This section shall not be construed so as
to divest the Board of Fish and Game of power to revoke,
suspend, or refuse issuance of a guide or assistant guide's
license in the exercise of its powers of regulation. [AND
SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GUIDE OR ASSISTANT GUIDE LICENSE
FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF REVOCATION.]

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
