IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the motor vehicle license tax; amending the first paragraph of Sec. 4(1), Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as last amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 134, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The first paragraph of Sec. 4(1), Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as last amended by Ch. 134, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

(1) LEVY AND RATE OF TAX. For the privilege of driving or moving any vehicle subject to registration under this Act upon any public highway in the State, constructed or maintained from state or federal aid funds, there is hereby levied an annual license tax. Such tax shall be at the rates specified in this section and shall be paid to and collected by the department at the time of making application for registration, or annual renewal of registration, as provided in this Act.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
