IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to minimum wages for employees; amending Ch. 171, SLA 1959; and providing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 4, Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

Sec. 4. MINIMUM WAGES. Every employer, except as may be otherwise provided in this Act, shall pay to each of his employees wages at a rate of not less than \$1.75 [\$1.50] an hour.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
