6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to overtime by state em-
7 ployees; amending paragraph (c) of Sec.
8 11-5-3, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-
9 enacted by Ch. 88, SLA 1955; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of Sec. 11-5-3, ACLA 1949, as
13 repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 88, SLA 1955, is amended to read:

14 (c) The heads of state [TERRITORIAL] departments or
15 [OF] agencies may require employees to work in excess of the
16 regular hours of employment, but such employees shall be
17 entitled to pay equal to one and one-half times the computed
18 hourly salary rate for their positions for each such hour
19 worked in excess of the regular hours of employment [AN EQUAL
20 AMOUNT OF LEAVE TIME AS COMPENSATION FOR SUCH WORK]. The
21 provisions of this subsection apply only to employees who do
22 not serve in supervisory, professional, or executive positions.
23 The overtime pay authorized by this subsection may be paid
24 only when the work has been authorized in advance and in
25 writing by an employee's immediate supervisor. The Commission-
26 er of Administration is authorized to promulgate such rules
27 and regulations for the employees of the executive branch as
28 are necessary to carry out the intent of this subsection.

Audit Committee, and the chief justice of the Supreme Court shall promulgate such rules and regulations for employees coming under their jurisdiction as are necessary to carry out the intent of this subsection.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1961.
