6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to Amend Chapter 94, Session Laws
7 of Alaska 1953, as amended, to provide for
8 a permit fee of \$25.00 and to provide that
9 the permit shall be effective until January
10 1 of the following year."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Section 3 (6) of Chapter 94, Session Laws of
13 Alaska 1953, is amended to read as follows:

14 (6) PERMIT FEES. Accompanying the Application for
15 a permit shall be the sum of \$25.00. All fees collected shall
16 be remitted to the Department of Revenue to be covered into the
17 General Fund. In addition to paying this fee, all persons con-
18 ducting employment agencies must comply with the provisions of
19 the Alaska Business License Act.

20 Section 2. Section 3 (7) of Chapter 94, Session Laws of
21 Alaska 1953, is amended to read as follows:

22 (7) EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF PERMIT, APPLICATION FOR
23 RENEWAL. A permit shall be effective until January 1 of the
24 year following issuance thereof. Thirty days prior to the
25 expiration of a permit the holder must apply for renewal of his
26 permit if the agency is to continue operation after the expirat-
27 ion date. The application for renewal shall contain all the
28 data requested in the original application, but brought up to
29 date where changes have occurred in location or ownership.

the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes
law without such approval.
