SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to private employment agencies; amending Ch. 94, SLA 1953; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3(6), Ch. 94, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

(6) PERMIT FEES. Accompanying the Application for a permit shall be the sum of \$25.00 [\$10.00]. All fees collected shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue [TREASURER OF ALASKA] to be covered into the General Fund. In addition to paying this fee, all persons conducting employment agencies must comply with the provisions of the Alaska Business License Act.

Sec. 2. Sec. 3(7), Ch. 94, SLA 1953 is amended to read:

(7) EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF PERMIT: APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL. A permit shall be effective until January 1 of the year following issuance thereof. Thirty days prior to the expiration of a permit the holder must apply for renewal of his permit if the agency is to continue operation after the expiration date. The application for renewal shall contain all the data requested in the original application, but brought up to date where changes have occurred in location or ownership.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
