SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to labor disputes and the obtaining of employees."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation not directly involved in a labor strike or lockout may recruit and bring into this state any person for employment, or secure or offer to secure employment for any person, when the purpose of recruiting, securing or offering to secure employment is to take the place in employment of employees in a business owned by a person, firm or corporation involved in a labor strike or lockout. No labor union may bring into this state, persons to act as pickets of a business owned by a person, firm or corporation where a labor strike or lockout exists. This Act does not apply to activities and services offered by or through the Alaska Department of Labor.

Sec. 2. A person who violates any provision of this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00, or imprisoned for a period not to exceed six months, or both.
