5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to labor disputes and the
7 obtaining of employees and pickets; and
8 providing penalties."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. No person, firm or corporation may recruit and
11 bring into this state any person for employment, or secure or
12 offer to secure employment for any person, when the purpose of
13 recruiting, employment, securing or offering to secure employment
14 is to take the place in employment of employees in a business
15 owned by a person, firm or corporation involved in a labor strike
16 or lockout. No labor union, person, firm or corporation may bring
17 into this state, persons to act as pickets of a business owned by
18 a person, firm or corporation where a labor strike or lockout
19 exists. This Act does not apply to activities and services offered
20 by or through the Alaska Department of Labor.

21 Sec. 2. A person who violates any provision of this Act is
22 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined
23 not more than \$1,000.00, or imprisoned for a period not to exceed
24 six months, or both.
