IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Alaska lands and resources; amending Sec. 5(4)f, Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 5(4)f, Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

f. In making any conveyance to an occupant, the Director shall include as a part of the tract conveyed, and in addition to the occupied or developed lands, such additional tide and submerged lands as shall be reasonably necessary in the opinion of the Director for such occupant's use and enjoyment of the occupied or developed land, but such conveyance shall not include any area which would unjustly deprive any occupant of adjoining lands from reasonable use and enjoyment thereof or which, if developed, will interfere with navigation, or which is of importance for water fowl production, public hunting, or recreational use. The Director shall consult with the Department of Fish and Game in establishing those areas important to water fowl production or public hunting.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
