BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The second paragraph, Sec. 1, Ch. 47, SLA 1959

as amended by Sec.1, Ch. 154, SLA 1960 is amended to read:

It is hereby declared to be the purpose of this Act to facilitate the commercial utilization of the natural resources of this state by authorizing the expenditure of funds to construct, relocate, or repair as many miles of pioneering access roads as is possible into and within areas rich in natural resources or to mining prospects of commercial promise which are inaccessible to truck haulage. The pioneering access roads authorized by this Act are envisaged as being essentially low standard, rudimentary truck roads, not usually fit for passenger automobile use and not necessarily subject to repair, upkeep, or seasonal maintenance. Construction of access roads of no more than six miles in length to natural resource sites used by a public utility comes within the purview of this Act.
