IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to jurisdiction over juveniles; amending the second paragraph of Sec. 4, Art. I, Ch. 145, SLA 1957; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The second paragraph of Sec. 4, Art I, Ch. 145, SLA 1957 is amended to read:

Provided, that said justice's court shall not have [MAY WAIVE] jurisdiction [TO THE CITY MAGISTRATE'S COURT] in the case of a minor who has violated any traffic statute [ORDINANCE] or regulation or any traffic ordinance or regulation of an incorporated municipality [; PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT WHEN JURISDICTION IS SO WAIVED TO THE MAGISTRATE'S COURT, THE PROCEDURE PRESCRIBED IN SECTIONS 5 THROUGH 10 OF THIS ARTICLE NEED NOT BE FOLLOWED, EXCEPT THAT A PARENT, GUARDIAN OR LEGAL CUSTODIAN SHALL BE PRESENT AT ALL PROCEEDINGS IN THE MAGISTRATE'S COURT].

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
