6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to power of eminent domain
7 of the Alaska State Housing Authority;
8 amending Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 8, Ch. 105, SLA 1951 is amended to read
12 as follows:

13 Section 8. EMINENT DOMAIN. The Authority shall have
14 the right to acquire by the exercise of the power of eminent
15 domain any real property which it may deem necessary within
16 the boundaries of a redevelopment project or for its pur-
17 poses under this Act after the adoption by it of a resolu-
18 tion declaring that the acquisition of the real property
19 described therein is necessary for such purposes. The
20 Authority may exercise the power of eminent domain in the
21 manner provided in Secs. 57-7-1 to 57-7-23 of the Compiled
22 Laws of Alaska, 1949, as supplemented and amended by Ch.90,
23 SLA 1953, as amended by Ch. 138, SLA 1955 and Ch.146, SLA
24 1959, and Ch. 134, SLA 1960, and acts amendatory thereof and
25 supplementary thereto. [, OR IT MAY EXERCISE THE POWER OF
26 EMINENT DOMAIN IN THE MANNER NOW OR WHICH MAY BE HEREAFTER
27 PROVIDED BY ANY STATUTORY PROVISIONS FOR THE EXERCISE OF THE
28 POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN.] Property already devoted to a
29 public use may be acquired in a like manner, provided that

no real property belonging to the municipality or the state
[TERRITORY] may be acquired without its consent.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day
after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law
without such approval.
